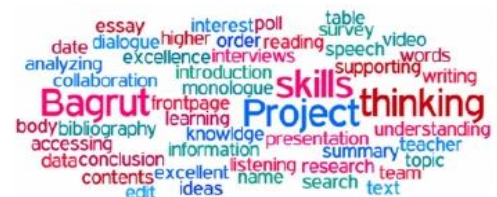

Bagrut in Theater

As always, everybody selects two electives to study in their 10th grade. In addition to electronics, physics, biology and software engineering there is theater too. In theater you can act like someone else and forget about all your problems for a moment. The theater elective is 5 points and Zita the head teacher of the theater adds: "the theater elective contains 30 percent of alternative assessment in which the students are examined on specific scenes and homework with a grade issued other specific scenes". In addition, she adds that there are 50 percent more of practical examination that are divided by 35 percent and 30 percent. The 35 percent contains a production of 30 minutes long of acting and the 30 percent contains an associate role like director, who is responsible for the lighting or for the music. The 25 percent from the whole 50 percent includes being a director and another 10 percent includes a dialog with an external examiner. The last 20 percent are not less important from other parts; theoretical exam which is done in the 12th grade.



Report about the robotics team

Our school's robotics team: "The Poros" 5554. participates in a robotics competition called FRC by an organization called FIRST.

The competition is a yearly event. In early January FIRST announces the details of a game to all participating teams.

The teams begin to design a robot to play the game. After the build season has ended, the teams must ship their robots to the place the FRC is held. The teams are randomly assigned alliances of 3 teams, which are paired into qualification matches, where they earn 'qualifying points'. The championship event is held every year in April, often in a large stadium or convention

center in the South-Eastern Coast of the United States. The championship event consists of four divisions of 85-95 teams competing on one of four fields: Galileo, Newton, Turing, and Hopper. The division champions then bring their robots over to the Einstein field to compete in an elimination tournament to determine the champion.

This year they finished the Israeli championship in the second rank and they were in second place.

they flew to Houston, Texas, to the world championship and we finished as the half-in fourth place.

The owners of the cafeteria were willing to listen to our problems and the day after they lowered prices on some of the products and brought more manpower.

Closers is a RPG (Role Playing Game) That was created by Masse Entertainment, and contains an epic story mode, along with fast paced "beat em up" style gameplay that resemble old school games like "Final fight" or "Streets of rage". The game was in open beta when I first joined it, and the full version of the game came out on February 6th, 2018.

The characters are divided into classes, each class has its own character. The playable classes are: Striker, Caster, Ranger, Fighter, Lancer and more (my personal favorite is the Striker class). New classes are coming as time progresses, so make sure to try them out. The setting of the story is in the near future, after an event called „The Dimensional War“, and it follows the character you chose as they defend the world from dimensional monsters that for various reasons come back to our dimension, going from area to area, clearing the dimensional monsters there, and defeating their leader to advance to the next area, only to learn that the world, as well as the people around them are not as they seem (you can do that in story mode to learn more about the world of the story and the character you are playing as, but you can also go and clear stages without story mode). In addition, you can play with your friends in squads of up to 4 people, and trade items between each other. A PvP mode is also available in the game. I also found the soundtrack of the game very good and fitting to the fast paced action in the stages and bosses.

The only thing I found bad about the game was the "Fatigue System", which limits the amount of stages you can play to prevent people from binge playing. That annoyed me at the beginning, but as I leveled up the limit increased, and I never reached the limit again.
